CLOSING OF THE SALE OF VACI GREENS' 6TH AND FINAL BUILDING (BUDAPEST, HUNGARY)

Following the agreement on the sale of the 6th and final building of the VACI GREENS project to a Hungarian private real estate fund in December 2020, ATENOR announces the deeds and the final sale today.



Delivered in mid-2020, the 6th and final building of the project (VACI GREENS Building F) is leased to 73% of reputable tenants such as NN Insurance, Sanofi and Intrum Justitia, one of the largest international debt management and collection companies.

Due to its size and quality, the VACI GREENS campus is one of the largest office projects in Budapest. It is also the first project in the Hungarian capital to be awarded the BREEAM "Excellent" certification in 2011.

The sale of this latest building closes the VACI GREENS project and confirms ATENOR's ability to deliver large-scale and high-quality projects, meeting the demand of local investors as well as international tenants.

Building on these commercial successes, ATENOR is reaping the full benefits of its development strategy in Central Europe and confirms its position as a major player in these particularly buoyant markets.
