"TreBel" building selected by the European Parliament

La Hulpe, 21 December 2011

The European Parliament has notified ATENOR GROUP that its offer concerning the TreBel building has been selected at the end of stage 1 of the call for tenders procedure concerning the acquisition of real estate launched by the European Parliament in December 2010.

This notification does not constitute a commitment by the European Parliament which can, until the signing of a contract, either abandon the contract, or cancel the contract award procedure.

As a reminder, on 19 November 2011, ATENOR announced the signing of an agreement for the acquisition of the building located on the corner of Rue Belliard and Rue de Trèves in Brussels, formerly the headquarters of BACOB, in the heart of the European District of Brussels.

On 17 October 2011, ATENOR submitted an application for a construction permit for a demolition-reconstruction project for this building.
